3. Course abstract

"The English language" course is communication-oriented and comprises 140 hours of class work and 112 hours of student self-study in accordance with the academic plan. The course syllabus is designed in consistence with the principles of competence and individual approach in teaching. These principles are implemented through topic-based selection of materials, interaction of speech activity types, stimulation of independent student learning, etc.

Verbal competence is practised in communicative situations of general topics (My family and I; Appearance and character; Hobbies and leisure time; Health and sports), educational topics (Education and study, Higher education in Russia and abroad); socio-cultural topics (English-speaking countries: sights and landmarks, traditions and culture; Environmental protection; Global problems; International tourism), professional topics (Business communication etiquette; Choosing a career; Attending a conference).

4. Course aims

The aims of "The English language" course include improving initial English language level; acquiring competences required to deal with socio-communicative tasks in different spheres of activity (general, cultural, professional and scientific) when interacting with foreign partners; expanding perspectives and increasing the general level of students' culture and education; developing learner autonomy skills; raising cultural awareness and tolerance.

5. Course objectives

Course objectives include developing speaking skills in general communicative situations; developing listening skills; developing reading skills for different reading strategies; developing productive writing skills. The above-mentioned skills practice is based on educational, cross-cultural and cultural materials of speech production and is aimed at comprehensive English language acquisition.

6. Competences

6.1. Competences required for studying the course

Critical thinking skills, generalizing and analyzing skills, perceiving information, setting a goal and ways to achieve it (CC-1);

6.2. Competences formed as a result of the course

Foreign language acquisition in oral and written forms to communicate successfully within general, educational, socio-cultural and professional communication areas at A2 - B1 levels of Common European Framework (CEFR) depending on the initial knowledge level of students; skills to give a presentation and hold a discussion (IC-2).

7. Course completion requirements

At the end of the course a student must

know basic vocabulary (4000 lexical units) and grammar, grammar structures required to learn oral and written forms of communication; the main characteristic features of texts typical of a foreign language in this or that communication area; different types of reading (intensive, skimming, scanning);

be able to express his/her ideas in a foreign language adequately to the situation and communication goal, understand an interlocutor speaking this language; have a dialogue on a general topic following the rules of speech etiquette, produce extended monologues; begin, carry on and finish a conversation, introduce him/herself and others, exchange information, express different emotions, attitudes, give a response to offers and suggestions, argument them; make good use of a dictionary;

have knowledge of the language sufficient to obtain information from foreign sources; skills to present his/her own opinions supported with arguments in writing; skills to speak in public, to provide argumentation, to hold a discussion and a debate; skills to provide different types of reasoning; receptive skills.
